Urgent Cares

- **American Family Care (AFC)**- multiple locations, closest to GHI is 2401 W. Cheltenham Ave. Wyncote PA 19095. Phone: 267-436-0322
Need to visit their website to schedule a virtual visit w/ their physician. If they determine you meet the criteria, they will test you on site.

 - 1212 Liggett Avenue, Reading, PA 19611 (8 a to 5 p)
 - These sites are focused exclusively testing COVID symptoms. If patient meets the criteria for COVID testing, their MD can write a script for COVID-19 testing and refer the patient to one of the locations listed above to have their test completed. Patients may also go to the urgent care sites without a script from their doctor but will need to be assessed on site if testing is appropriate. All sites are open 9A-9P except for the Liggett Ave which is open 8A-8P. All are open Monday through Friday

- **CVS**
 - Must go to their website, www.cvs.com, to complete prescreening. If you qualify, the website will prompt to schedule an appt at one of the local CVS.
NOTE: Not all CVS offer testing
- **Rite Aid**
 - Must go to their website, www.riteaid.com, to complete prescreening. If you qualify, the website will prompt to schedule an appt at one of the local Rite Aid. Not all Rite Aid offer testing

- **Philadelphia**

- **Montgomery County** opened 6 COVID-19 walk-up testing sites located throughout the County. Testing is open for anyone who needs or wants to be tested. Patients may register online by visiting www.montcopa.org/COVID-19 and selecting County Testing at the top of the page. Phone registration is available by calling 610.970.2937 starting at 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the intended appointment until all slots are filled. Spanish-speaking operators are available.
 - **Pottstown** - Montgomery County Office of Public Health, 364 King Street. Testing is available: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from noon to 2 p.m. Tuesday/Thursday from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
 - **Lansdale** – 421 Main Street. Testing is available: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday/Thursday from noon to 2 p.m.
 - **Willow Grove** – Montgomery County Office of Public Health, 102 York Road (this site will be moving). Testing is available: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from noon to 2 p.m. Tuesday/Thursday from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
 - **Green Lane** – Deep Creek and Snyder Road. Testing is available: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday/Thursday from noon to 2 p.m.
 - **Ardmore** – 114 W. Lancaster Ave. Testing is available: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday/Thursday from noon to 2 p.m.
 - **Norristown** – Delaware Valley Community Health Center at the Norristown Regional Health Center at 1401 Dekalb Street. This site will open on Tuesday, July 7, with hours of operation to be announced in the coming days.

Testing at Hospitals (if you see a specialist within a hospital system, see if they can give a referral)

- **Penn Medicine** offers multiple Walk-In and Drive-Thru Testing Sites. Accessible to anyone who is experiencing coronavirus like symptoms. You do not need to be a Penn patient to be tested and you do not need a referral from a MD to be tested. If you are not a Penn patient and are having symptoms, Penn encouraged patients to call 800-789-7366. Patients will be screened on site.

 - **Sayre Health Center Testing Site** (Site entrance located in parking lot behind Sayre High School) 227 S. 59th St. Phila, PA. Testing hours: 10A-3p, Mon- Wed and Fri; 12p-3p Thursday. Highly encouraged patients to

- **West Philadelphia Testing Site Parking lot** (formerly referred to as 4040 Market St) 4122 Market St. Phila PA. Testing hours: 8A-1:30p Mon- Fri. Penn encourages patients to make an appointment by calling 267-414-2303
- **Jefferson-** mobile testing sites at all major hospitals. 8a-5p. An in-network provider refers you for testing, you will be scheduled for an appointment and provided instructions about the process to be seen at a Jefferson Testing Site. If you do not have a PCP, you can use [JeffConnect](#) to virtually connect with Jefferson doctors through your cell phone, tablet or computer with a webcam. Download the JeffConnect app or visit [JeffConnect.org](#), available 24/7.
- **Temple Hospital-** Testing is for in network patients only who meet certain criteria and only offered at locations on hospital campuses. Patient triage hotline 215-707-6999. Routine testing for COVID not available in any of their ERs.
- **Main Line Health-** Need to be referred by in network provider. Call your primary care doctor for an assessment
